SUPPORT

- HR Assistant help get the word out to various schools and set up appointments for interviews with me, send follow up mails, update the online "Handshake" pages.
- Sales selling concerts to venues, selling group tickets for shows and events, scheduling artist displays for venues, selling space to vendors for events NOTE: Sales interns receive 10% gross of what comes in from their direct sales.
- General Clerical sorting papers, filing them, phone calls, emails, chats, typing letters, sorting/filing digital files, updating passwords for online accounts, maintaining databases, updating information packets for customers
- Database Entry Clerk we have A LOT of details to enter each day into various databases copyright registrations, product information, vendor information and updates, advertising sponsors information, equipment maintenance records, and more. This is a position that is ideally suited for someone in a wheelchair or who has autism. But the position is open to ANYONE who is excellent with details and accuracy in data entry.
- Video Editing Assistant logging footage, typing up the script for the editor, following up and reviewing the editors work for accuracy in the script.

SKILLED

- Video Editor editing shows for internet distribution, concert footage for DVDs, event snippets for promotional purposes online, and small theater commercials.
- Graphic Design creating concert and event/show posters & Leaflets, editing photos for internet postings
- Legal Helper help with preparing the copyright and trademark registrations for review by our lawyer. Doing legal research on topics, searching online for noncontracted sites distributing or posting our materials and content and preparing take down notices
- Accounting Helper scour the database looking for discrepancies, double
 checking that the numbers are correct, and all entries are accurate, helping
 prepare the information for our accountant.

ON-SITE - MAY REQUIRE PHYSICAL ABILITIES

- Pre-Production printing the posters and leaflets and cutting them, assimilating show programs, banners/logo updates, and helping with prop preparations and equipment rentals before events
- **Production Crew** picking up equipment, setup location, clean up, teardown, and packing the equipment back into our locker. Inventorying use on each piece of equipment after each event
- Poster Hangers hanging posters and distributing leaflets for our events and services, across the northwest suburbs. Can use a bike, car or train. Train and/or gas are reimbursed.
- **Sound** setup, monitor and teardown the sound for area events (northwest suburbs)
- Production Assistant following up and gathering release forms from artists, assisting with the audience needs, working with other interns at events to guide with setup/cleanup/teardown and timeliness, works with the producer on each event to help fill in missing tasks/roles/errands, and gather props if needed.
- Special Note: One paid position: "Zombies" "Zombies" are paid positions Looking for people who enjoy entertaining audiences as zombies (without saying the audience). We are silly, ugly, and silent, and we have a ton of fun distributing goody bags to audiences in parades across northern Illinois and Indian, and southern Wisconsin and Michigan.

 attendees.
- Mrs. Claus Stories online Mrs. Claus zooms into Christmas Eve at 7pm with stories from the north pole, and her adventures with the elves, Santa and those flying reindeer. A 1-hour interactive conversation with Mrs. Claus.
